- *Mail each of your team members a thank you note, praising each of them for specific things they do well.* In the days of email, it's always a pleasant surprise to receive a handwritten note in the mail.
- *Do you know your team members' favorite candy or coffee?* Surprise your team with a small "thinking of you" treat.
- *Add some relationship-building to your next leadership meeting.* It could be fun (sharing baby photographs) or meaningful (sharing a favorite holiday memory).
- *Encourage your team to share their prayer requests with you.* Follow through and pray for members' specific needs.
